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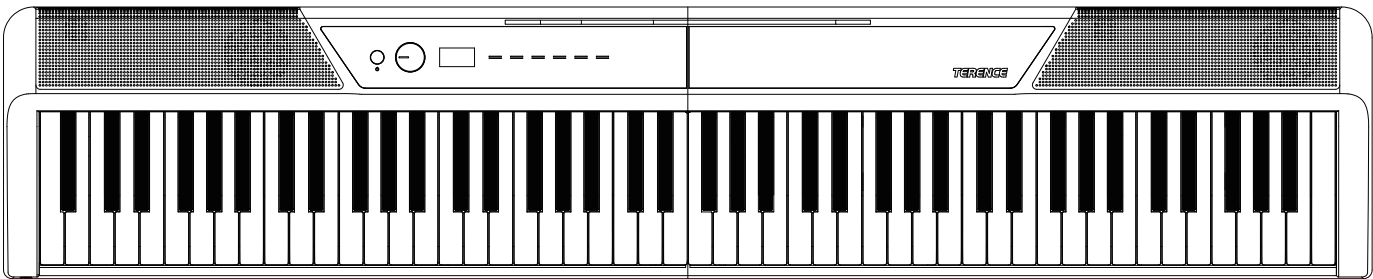
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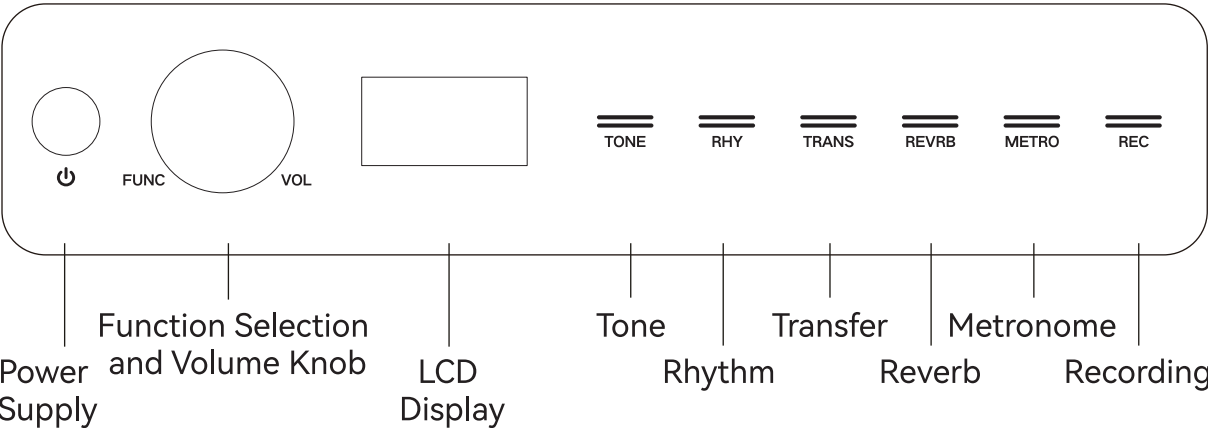
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Function Introduction

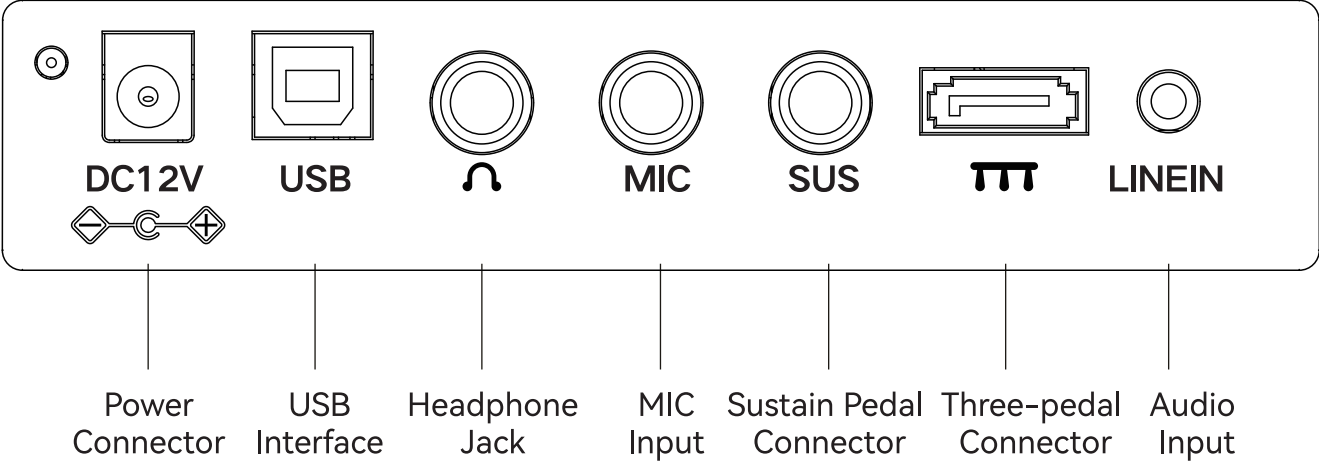
1.General Appearance



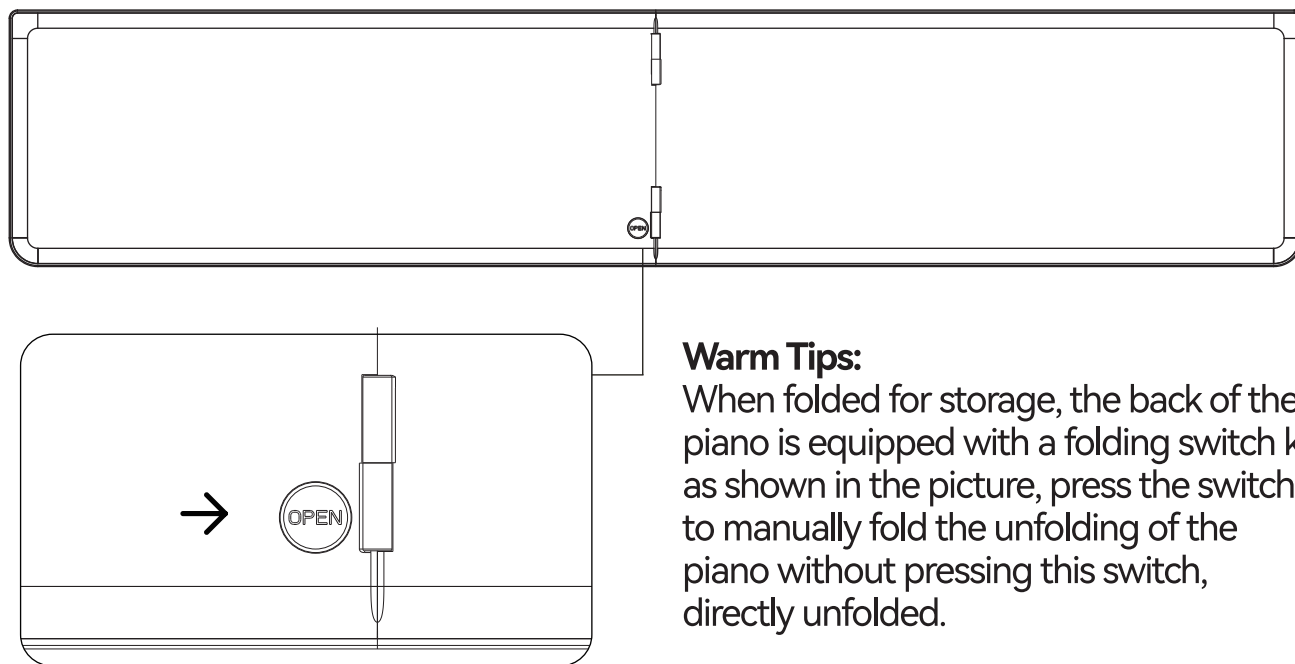
2.Panel Function Diagram

Warm Tips:

When folded for storage, the back of the piano is equipped with a folding switch key as shown in the picture, press the switch down to manually fold the unfolding of the piano without pressing this switch, directly unfolded.

5.Product Function Description

Power On/Off Button

Long press the power switch for 3 seconds to switch on/off.

Function Selection and Volume Knob

1. [Knob] Power on default is volume (VOLUME) adjustment mode, rotate left and right to select the volume level.
2. Volume VOLUME can be selected from 0 to 16, the default is 12.
3. Short press [knob] to enter the menu, rotate the [knob] left and right to enter the selection function, short press to enter the menu settings and short press again to enter the function to confirm, 5 seconds without any operation to return to the volume interface mode.

Tone Button

1. Press the [Tone] button. Rotate the volume knob to switch the tone, and return to the volume interface mode without any operation for 5 seconds.
2. Double-click the [Tone] button to restore the default tone.

Rhythm Button

1. Press the [Rhythm] button to play, then press the [Rhythm] button to stop, rotate the [knob] left and right to select the rhythm.
2. Rhythm volume: Long press the [Rhythm] button, rotate the volume knob to adjust the rhythm volume.
3. Rhythm tempo: double-click the [Rhythm] button to enter the rhythm tempo adjustment interface, rotate the volume knob to adjust the rhythm tempo.
4. Click the knob to stop playing the rhythm.
5. 5 seconds without any operation to return to the volume interface mode.

Transfer Button

1. Click the [Transfer] button to display the current pitch, rotate the volume knob to adjust the pitch.
2. Double-click [Transfer] button to restore the default C key.
3. 5 seconds without any operation to return to the volume interface mode.

Reverb Button + Demo Song Function

1. Click the [Reverb] button to switch the reverb function on/off. After switching on the reverb function, rotate the volume knob to select the type of reverb, Church, Room, Auditorium, Concert Hall.
2. Reverb Depth: Long press the [Reverb] button, rotate the volume knob to adjust the reverb depth of the current reverb type.
3. Demonstration Song: Double press the [Reverb] button to play the demonstration song, rotate the volume knob to select the switching demonstration song. Short press the volume knob to stop playing the demo song.
4. 5 seconds without any operation to return to the volume interface mode.

Metronome Function

1. Short press the [Metronome] button to select: 1/4, 2/4, 3/4, 4/4, Off.
2. Metronome speed: After switching on the metronome, rotate the volume knob to adjust the metronome speed.
3. Short press the volume knob to stop playing the metronome
4. 5 seconds without any operation to return to volume interface mode.

Recording Function

1. Double-click [Rec] button to start/stop recording. Click the [Rec] button to play back the recording and then click the [Rec] button again to stop playing the recording.

Strength

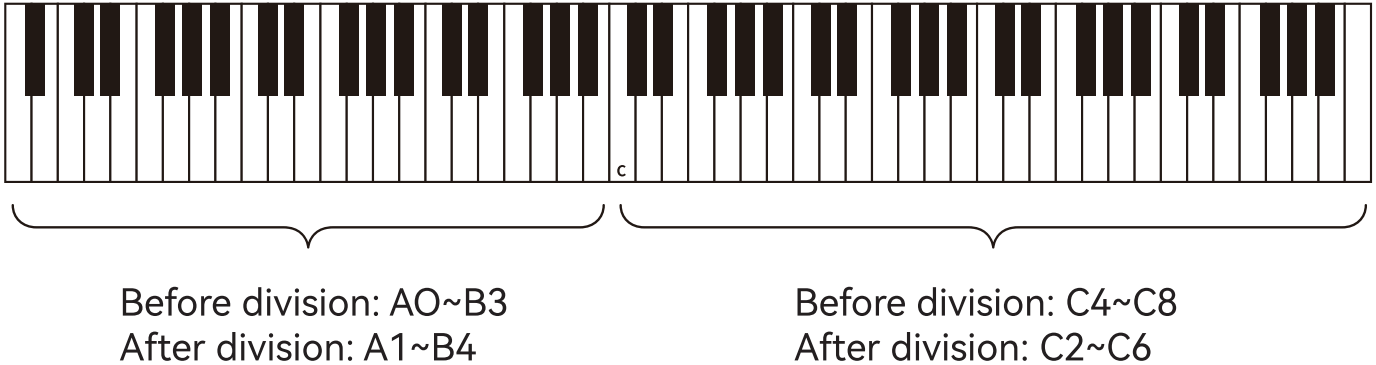
1. Short press the [Knob] and rotate it to [Strength] to select the strength.
2. Lightly press the knob, then rotate the [knob] left and right to turn on the strength function in turn, off, light, medium and heavy.
3. 5 seconds without any operation to return to the volume interface mode.

Bluetooth

1. Short press [Knob], rotate to [Bluetooth] to select Bluetooth.
2. Lightly press the knob, then rotate the [knob] left and right to turn on/off the Bluetooth function.
3. 5 seconds without any operation to return to volume interface mode.

Dual Keyboard

1. Short press the [knob] button, rotate the [knob] button to select [Dual Keyboard].
2. After short pressing the [knob] button, rotate the [knob] button left or right to turn the dual keyboard function on or off. The tone selected before turning on the dual keyboard function will apply to the right-hand keys. You must press the tone button to switch before turning on the dual sound function. To change the tone of the left-hand keys, simply press the tone button after turning on the dual keyboard function. Once selected, the tones for the left and right-hand key areas will be two different tones when playing.



Dual Tone

1. Short press the [knob] button, rotate the [knob] button to select [Dual Tone].
2. After short pressing the [knob] button, rotate the [knob] button left or right to turn the dual tone function on or off. The tone selected before turning on the dual tone function will be the primary tone. You must press the tone button to switch before turning on the dual tone function. To change the second tone, simply press the tone button after turning on the dual tone function. Once selected, the two tones will be layered when playing.

Vibrato

1. Short press the [Knob] and rotate it to [Vibrato].
2. Press the [Knob] lightly and then rotate the [Knob] left or right to select Vibrato on or off to produce a vibrato effect in your performance. 5 seconds without any operation to return to the volume interface mode.

Synchronisation

1. Short press the [Knob] and rotate it to [Sync].
2. Tap the knob, and then rotate the [Knob] left or right to turn on/off the Sync function.
3. 5 seconds without any operation to return to volume interface mode.

Sustain Function

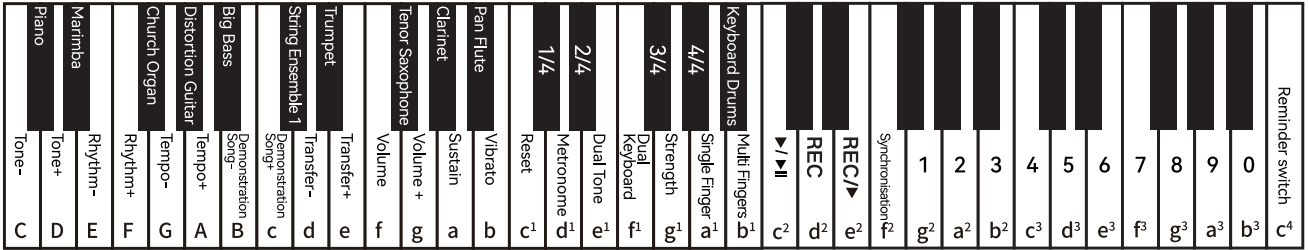
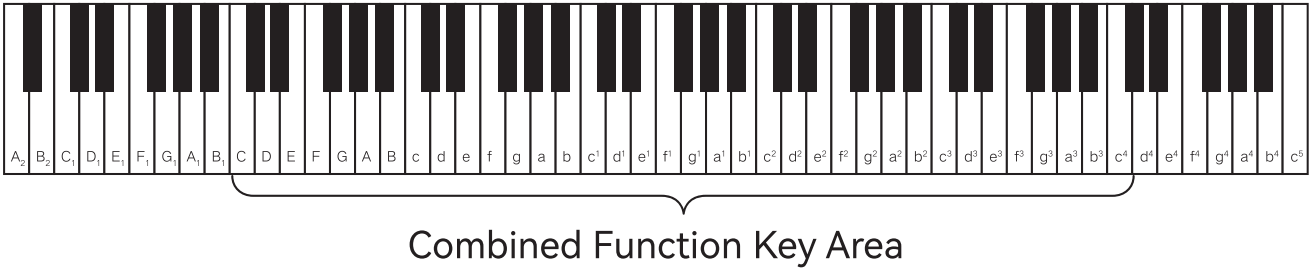
1. Short press the [Knob] and rotate it to [Sound Delay].
2. Tap the knob, then rotate the [knob] left or right to turn on/off the sustain function.
3. 5 seconds without any operation to return to the volume interface mode.

Bluetooth Audio Function

Bluetooth function is automatically turned on after power on, Bluetooth has been turned on waiting to connect to the mobile phone to play backing tracks or music mobile phone search to 'TERENCE PIANO' to connect, enter the password: 8888, volume up or down or music selection needs to be done on the mobile phone.

Compound Function Usage

Press and hold the [Knob] and press the corresponding function key to get the corresponding function.



1. In the case of compound function keys, the operation of timbre, rhythm, tempo, demonstration song, volume and other functions can be directly selected by the number keys (g2-b3).
2. When the dual tone function is turned on, the left piano key is fixed to the piano tone, the right key is the string tone by default when the dual tone function is turned on, and the right key tone can be switched to a total of 128 kinds of tones, and the operation of the composite function button can switch the right key tone.
